#### Public Testimony Guidelines:

Speakers are encouraged to submit comments in writing. See "Procedures for Correspondence to the Commissioners" below.

### Consent Calendar Guidelines:

The Consent Calendar allows the Joint Subcommittee to take action with no discussion on projects to which no one objects. The Joint Subcommittee may place items on the Consent Calendar if no one present wishes to testify on an item. Anyone present who wishes to speak on an item should submit a speaker card prior to the start of the meeting, or raise his or her hand and advise the Chairperson, and the item will be pulled from the Consent Calendar for public comment and discussion prior to action.
